The "WHY:

- A team approach provides voice to classroom teachers with a broad range of insight and expertise.
- Review and refinement of alignment to standards and the measure of standard mastery.
- Examine relevant data.
- Develop action steps as a result of data examination.
- Review and update relevant district documents.

As a result of the two meetings during second semester 2016, a spelling survey for elementary classroom teachers was implemented. That data will be reviewed at the first meeting of 2016-17. An ACT preparation test will be investigated for the HS.

Reading Fidelity Tier 1 Inventory

Northfield Public Schools received a grant through Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) for 2016-17 to implement an inventory and study of the Tier 1

reading and literacy program. The inventory will be given to each of the three elementary schools September 20-22, 2016. The data will be reviewed and district and building action plans will be developed as a result of that review. Each elementary school has named a team to participate. At least two of those members also serve on the District Literacy Team.
