This is a mandatory training for all PCA's and for Special Ed. teachers in Low Incidence programs or those that work with medically fragile students

Bloodborne Pathogens:

This is mandatory annual training for all PCA's, Special Ed. teachers in Low Incidence programs or those that work with medically fragile student

When you have completed the training you may print a copy of the completion certificate for your own records. I do not need a copy.

Educational Assistant (EA) – Personal Care Assistant (PCA) Training

This training is mandatory for NEW PCAs who work in Special Education. If you are brand new or you were hired last year, but never trained, this training IS FOR YOU.

Training includes body mechanics, transfers, assistance with walking (gait), and the use of a mechanical lift. (Hoyer Lift).
