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Dear High School Faculty and Staff:

- MEET THE TEACHER NIGHT this year is the evening of September 17th (please note this is a **Wednesday** evening), from 6:30-8:30. Please mark your calendars for this event.

On *Monday*, *August 25th* and *Tuesday*, *August 26th*, NHS faculty will report to the high school for breakfast, staff development (4 hours Monday/2 hours Tuesday) and work time (4 hrs Monday/6 hrs Tuesday). *Wednesday*, *August 27th* and *Thursday August 28th* are each slated for 2 hours of staff development time (iPads, Schoology expectations, PLCs, dept meetings), with the rest of the day given to you for work time.
