Policy 513.3 - Advanced Grade Placement

It shall be the policy of the Northfield Board of Education to allow advanced

grade placement provided that a child demonstrates specified superior levels of

intellectual, academic, adaptive and physical development; and, in the judgment of school

personnel, will benefit from such placement. Such decisions shall be made cautiously

due to the possible negative consequences for a student who spends his/her school career

as the youngest member in the identity group.

Applications for Advanced Grade Placement must be submitted in writing to the

principal by the parent(s) or guardian(s) seeking advanced grade placement for their

child. The district shall have 30 school days to complete the assessment.
