610.1 SCHOOL ASSEMBLY PROGRAMS

I. General Statement of Policy

School assembly programs must have educational, cultural and/or entertainment value consistent with the values and objectives of the school district and community as determined by the Board of Education. For the purposes of this policy, an assembly is defined as a large group presentation activity during the school day provided by an organization or individual external to the district to all classrooms at a grade level or a mix of students comprising at least twenty percent of the student body.

II. Approval

School assembly programs must be approved by the Board of Education or the Superintendent of Schools or designee prior to signing a contract and committing school district resources to the activity.
