

2014-2015 No Meetings / No Activities

Bold signifies **no** meetings or activities at all

Not bold signifies no meetings during which public business is conducted only

- **Primary Election, if required - August 12, 2014 (2nd Tuesday in August) – Except for regularly scheduled classes, a public elementary or secondary school may not schedule a school sponsored event or meeting between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.** (M.S. 204C.03, Subdivision 1 and 3)
- Columbus Day – October 14, 2014 (2nd Monday in October) – No meetings during which public business is conducted. However, since our School Board is declaring that it is NOT a holiday, we're okay to hold meetings.
- **Election Day - November 4, 2014 (1st Tues in Nov) - Except for regularly scheduled classes, a public elementary or secondary school may not schedule a school sponsored event or meeting between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.** (M.S. 204C.03, Subdivision 1 and 3)
- Veterans Day – Tuesday, November 11, 2014 - No meetings during which public business is conducted
- Thanksgiving - November 27, 2014 - No meetings during which public business is conducted.
- Christmas Day - December 25, 2014 - No meetings during which public business is conducted.
- New Years Day - January 1, 2015 - No meetings during which public business is conducted.
- Martin Luther King Day - January 19, 2015 (3rd Mon in Jan) - No meetings during which public business is conducted.
- President's Day - February 16, 2015 (3rd Mon in Feb) - No meetings during which public business is conducted.
- **Township Election - March 10, 2015 (2nd Tues in Mar) - Except for regularly scheduled classes, a public elementary or secondary school may not schedule a school sponsored event or meeting between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.** (M.S. 205.075, Subdivision 1 and M.S. 204C.03, Subdivision 1 and 3)
- Memorial Day - May 25, 2015 - No meetings during which public business is conducted.

School Districts have the option of having school on Veterans Day (Nov 11), MLK Day (Jan 19), and Presidents Day (Feb 16), which we do in Northfield except MLK Day on Jan 19. However, it must be part of the teacher contract that on Veterans Day, MLK Day, and Presidents Day if school is being held, **at least one hour of school must be devoted to a patriotic observance of the day. (MS 120A.42).**
