

## NORTHFIELD HIGH SCHOOL

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Dear High School Faculty and Staff:

I hope this letter finds you well, and that your summer break has been restful and exhilarating! As I typically do in this letter, I would like to introduce some new staff who will be joining us this fall. **Lukas Brott** joins our Biology team, as Dan Taylor moves to chemistry to replace Kim Milne. **Tyler Balow** joins the social studies department from Decorah High School and will teach world history and civics. **Ray Coudret** returns to the math department after serving as assistant principal at the middle school. **Anne Campbell** joins our special education department and replaces John Mahal as the level 2/3 EBD classroom teacher, and **Nicole Gill** takes over in our low incidence program for the recently retired Kathy Lean. Also in special education, **Danielle Crase** steps in for Taylor Murray who is moving to Bridgewater Elementary. Additionally we will be hiring a new part-time FACS teacher to replace MaryJo Arndt, part-time social studies replacing Erin Carson, and another special education teacher. We also welcome school psychologist **Marcy Korynta**, who will be here .6 FTE and allow Carrie Duba to move into a .6 FTE MTSS role. Welcome to you all!

There are a number of returning staff in new or expanded roles with us as well. Liz Pfieffer returns in special education, but moves from EBD to resource and will be shared between the high school and ALC. Liz takes over for Elaine Harries. Katie Casson returns in the German department this fall, but this time as the entire department, replacing Deborah Winkleman. She will also teach one section at the middle school. Amanda Tracy increased her FTE from .2 to .8 in the Spanish Department. Lisa Battaglia and Carrie Duba, as I mentioned above, will coordinate the MTSS initiative. Leah Sand returns to the physical education department after coordinating MTSS at the MS and HS.

A few specific items for your attention:

- Regarding the FIRST day of workshops, look for information from Site Council about the potluck breakfast.
- Students will be receiving their iPads on August 18th from 12-6 and 25th from 12-6, and electronic schedules will go live on August 26th. - First Day 9th graders arrive at regular time for LINK activities. All staff needs to be out of rooms from 9:30-11:00. All students run 15 minute class/5 minute passing time schedule starting at 12:30 p.m. 9th graders will have nothing w/ them when they come to your classes. LINK leaders will not be in 7th hour.
- We will do class meetings again this fall. Class meetings will occur on <u>Friday</u>, <u>September 11th</u>. 12<sup>th</sup> graders: period 3; 11<sup>th</sup> graders period 2; 10<sup>th</sup> graders period 5; 9<sup>th</sup> graders period 7.
- Picture day will happen simultaneously with iPad distribution. Picture makeup day is October 1st from 7:30-12:00 in the auditorium.
- MEET THE TEACHER NIGHT this year is the evening of September 16<sup>th</sup> (please note this is again a **Wednesday** evening), from 6:30-8:30. Please mark your calendars for this event.

Teachers new to the district will report to the middle school the morning of *Wednesday, August 26th*, and will continue their orientation *Thursday, August 27th*. On *Monday, August 31st*, NHS faculty will report to the high school for breakfast, staff development (1 hour) and work time (4 hours). *Tuesday, September 1st* secondary staff will be in the HS auditorium for a day of training around common formative assessment. *Wednesday, September 2nd* is 4 hours of staff development (technology, Casper, and building staff development) and 3 hours of work time. Finally, *Thursday September 3rd* is slated for 4 hours of Mental Health First Aid training and with the rest of the day given to you for work time. A more detailed schedule of SD activities will be available from MaryGrace Hanson somewhere near where you found this letter!

I wish each of you an enjoyable remainder of the summer break, and we'll see you on the 31th.
