School Board Meeting November 27, 2006 Northfield High School Media Center

I. Call to Order.

Chairperson Kari Nelson called the meeting of the Board of Education of Independent School District 659 to order at 7:05 p.m. Cirksena was absent.

1. FY 2006 Audit Report.

Bob Qualset, auditor for the Northfield School District, reviewed the audit figures for the 2005-2006 school year with the Board. The results show that the District has achieved step one of the long-term financial plan, which is the elimination of statutory operating debt. However, the auditor reminded the Board of the need to rebuild the fund balance to provide enough dollars to fund between one and two months of operation. Maintaining this level of fund balance would help protect the District from having to make budget cuts in the future if state funding is not adequate.

2. Elementary and Community Services Site Continuous Improvement Plan Presentations. Bridgewater, Sibley and Greenvale Park Elementary Schools and Community Services presented their site continuous improvement plans to the Board. The site continuous improvement plan presentations first focused on describing the site improvement goals and the data or evidence that was used to identify those goals. They also presented their annual progress reports from the 2005-06 school year detailing the progress made on their improvement goals from last year.
