School Board Meeting January 8, 2007 Northfield High School Media Center

I. Call to Order.

Chairperson Kari Nelson called the meeting of the Board of Education of Independent School District 659 to order at 7:17 p.m. Cirksena and Smith were absent.

VI. Items for Discussion and / or Reports

1. Implementation of Wellness Policy.

Food Services Coordinator Julie Kronabetter and Greenvale Park Principal Jeff Roland provided the Board with an update on the various activities that have been completed since approval of the wellness policy last year. The work of the Wellness Committee has focused on four main areas: (1) Physical Activity, (2) Vending, Concessions and Classrooms, (3) Food and Beverages - Reimbursable Meals, and (4) A la Carte. While much has been accomplished in the past year, the Wellness Committee hopes to take a closer look at vending machines and concessions during the remainder of this school year.

2. Update on Federal Title Programs.

Dr. Gary Lewis, Director of Student Services, presented an update on Federal Title programs within the District. The presentation included a brief description of each of the Title areas, current allocations, and how the District is utilizing those dollars.

3. Enrollment Projection and Budget Development.

Director of Business Affairs Tom Stringer reviewed the enrollment assumptions that drive the 2007-08 budget development and five-year financial forecast. The enrollment model uses a traditional cohort survival technique that measures the historical trend/growth of each class from one year to the next based on consistent October 1 counts. The model further averages the last four years of these "survival ratios" to project future grade sizes. In addition, the budget calendar for developing the 2007-08 budget was reviewed.

VIII. Items for Information

1. Tackling Obstacles and Raising College Hopes (TORCH) Grant Received.

The Northfield Public Schools, in collaboration with Familias en Accion, the Northfield Healthy Community Initiative and the Northfield Mentoring Coalition has received a \$39,945 grant from the State of Minnesota's Juvenile Justice Advisory Council - MN Department of Public Safety, to continue the work of TORCH. TORCH uses academic tutoring, mentoring, enrichment activities, out-of-school time programming, and family connectedness efforts to assure local Latino students remain in school, graduate from high school, and have access to postsecondary opportunities.

2. Paraprofessional Recognition Week, January 15 - 19, 2007.

The Governor of the State of Minnesota has proclaimed the week of January 15-19 as Paraprofessional Recognition Week. Paraprofessionals, or in the Northfield School District, Educational Assistants, are persons who are essential to every school. They work in a variety of positions in a school district. Buildings will recognize the contributions of paraprofessionals during the week of January 15th.

3. <u>Informational Meeting on Wind Turbine Project, January 12, 2007.</u>

The Northfield School District has received formal notification from the Internal Revenue Service that the fourteen school districts, including Northfield, who applied for CREBS funding for the construction of a wind turbine farm in partnership with Johnson Controls has been approved. These schools districts have until December 2007 to sell the bonds and begin the implementation of this project. Superintendent Richardson has been meeting with six of the fourteen schools on an informal basis during the last two months to discuss how the school district would need to proceed if the project was approved. Now that the formal approval has been received, the Superintendents have arranged two meetings in January for all fourteen districts to address several important concerns. Noel Stratmoen is the School Board representative for this project.
