School Board Meeting May 14, 2007 Northfield High School Media Center

I. Call to Order.

Chairperson Kari Nelson called the meeting of the Board of Education of Independent School District 659 to order at 7:00 p.m. Hager and Stratmoen were absent.

II. Agenda Changes.

III. Public Comment.

IV. Approval of Minutes.

V. Announcements.

- Eight high school students and Shari Hagen, High School Spanish Teacher, presented a slide show of their trip to Costa Rica over Spring Break.
- May 9 was National School Nurse day. The school district is fortunate to have great nurses and we extend our thanks to them for the wonderful job they do for our students.
- The Invest in the Future luncheon and early literacy awareness event for community leaders on April 12 featuring Al Quie was co-sponsored by the Northfield Early Childhood Initiative Coalition and the Northfield Rotary Club. The project was awarded a literacy project award by the Rotary District 5960. The Northfield Rotary Club has been a strong supporter of early literacy issues in the community.
- Northfield High School drama presented "An Evening of Culture", directed by Kevin Dahle on May 4,5,11,12 in the high school auditorium.
- Northfield High School's girls' golf team has been ranked as high as 5th in the state by the Mpls Tribune and won the Farmington Stan Otness Tournament for the first time ever. The golf team is coached by Brian Stevens.

1. Proposed 2007-08 Operating Capital/Health and Safety and Community Services Budgets. Tom Stringer presented the proposed Operating Capital and Health & Safety budget for 2007-08. A district capital committee and the Technology Steering Committee met numerous times during the year to review and prioritize requests from all buildings. Included in this budget is the new Capital Projects Levy revenue of \$750,000. After our basic commitments are met, three areas could be funded at substantially higher levels because of the new levy: textbooks, technology and deferred maintenance projects in buildings. Following Tom Stringer's presentation, Director of Community Services Hannah Puczko presented the Community Services Budget for 2007-2008.
