# 3. Certify Final 2008 Payable 2009 Tax Levy.

On a motion by Berthelsen, seconded by Cirksena, the Board unanimously certified to County Auditors the 2008 Payable 2009 Final Certified Net Tax Levy in the amount of \$14,366,599.07.

Nhung Bui, PLUS Program Site Assistant at Greenvale Park for 2.0 hours, T/Th, and 0.75 hr/day on M/W for a total of 5.5 hours per week, December 1, 2008 May 29, 2009, step 1 of the wage scale for Site Assistants, subject to revision when negotiations for 2008-09 are completed. This is in addition to her EA position at the Middle School.
- 3. Theresa Brake, PLUS Program Site Assistant at Greenvale Park for 0.75 hr, 4 days per week for a total of 3.0 hours per week, December 1, 2008 May 29, 2009, step 3 of the wage scale for Site Assistants, subject to revision when negotiations for 2008-09 are completed.
