# **CARES Act Allocations**

The following table provides each district or charter school's allocation for each of the three CARES Act funding streams administered by the Minnesota Department of Education.

Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) funds can be used for technology and summer school programming.

Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds are used two ways:

- 90% of these funds are distributed in a formula to districts and charter schools using the same formula used for Title I, Part A funds under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act.
- 9.5% of these funds are distributed through grants that provide funding to districts and charter schools that don't receive a formula allocation, receive less than \$10,000 from their formula allocation, and/or receive a smaller share of ESSER funds than their share of the state's historically underserved student populations.
