Communication, Assignments & Grades

Please keep in mind the importance of considering the *big picture* of your student's academic progress. If your student has missed an assignment or did not perform to a level you would have expected, please start with a conversation with them. This is a great way to help your student take responsibility for their learning. And of course, we are always here if you need us.

SCHOOLOGY

This is the place where assignments are posted, submitted and graded. Grades then sync to Skyward (but not always right away).



For the most part, all materials and directions for assignments can be found in Schoology.

Whenever you have a question about an assignment, start here first!

NMS PRIDE PLANNER: This is where students will record all of their assignments each day. Students should use this information to prioritize their assignments and make a plan to complete them.

SKYWARD (FAMILY ACCESS)

Family Access enables you to monitor your student's academic progress. We recommend that you become familiar with it, as it is used district-wide at all grade levels.



Check here first for grades and missing assignments. If your student disputes a missing assignment, they should check Schoology to see it it was indeed turned in. If so, the student should contact the teacher to let them know.

iPads: Students will use their iPads on a daily basis. They should bring their iPads fully charged every day, along with their earbuds. We recommend bringing their charging blocks and cords as well, just in case. Please be sure iPads are clearly labeled with first and last names.

DAILY LESSON HIGHLIGHTS (DLH)

This is a helpful tool to see at a glance what has been assigned each day in all of your student's core classes. This is posted at the top of each teacher's Schoology page. Please check it often to see what we've been up to!

When you have questions about your student's assignments or something that occurred at school, we recommend following these steps to find the answers:
