

Communication, Assignments & Grades

Please keep in mind the importance of considering the big picture of your student's academic progress. If your student has missed an assignment or did not perform to a level you would have expected, please start with a conversation with them. This is a great way to help your student take responsibility for their learning. And of course, we are always here if you need us.

SCHOOLOGY

This is the place where teachers post assignments, directions and resources. It is also where students submit their completed assignments. If you have a question about an assignment, start here.



NMS PRIDE PLANNER: This is where students will record all of their assignments each day. Students should use this information to prioritize their assignments and check them off as they complete them.

SKYWARD (FAMILY ACCESS)

This is where you go to check grades and get a list of all missing assignments. Check Skyward (Family Access) often to monitor academic standing and progress. Skyward is used district-wide at all grade levels.



DAILY LESSON HIGHLIGHTS (DLH)

This is your one-stop-shop to see what has been covered and assigned each day in all five core classes. The link is posted at the top of each teacher's Schoology page. Please bookmark it and check it often to see what we are up to!

When you have questions about your student's assignments or something that occurred at school, we recommend following these steps to find the answers:



Talk with your student. Check their planner and Daily Lesson Highlights.



Then, if needed, refer to Schoology and Skyward to see if your questions can be answered there.



Finally, if questions remain, contact your student's teacher(s) for more information.

iPads: Students will use their iPads on a daily basis. They should bring their iPads fully charged every day, along with their earbuds. We recommend bringing their charging blocks and cords as well, just in case. Please be sure iPads are clearly labeled with first and last names.
