**Please reset your password to your school password that you use for other things (first letter of first name + first five letters of last name + lunch/Media Center code)**

1. Click **Forgot Your Password?** from the Naviance Student login screen.
2. The student or parent should **type their current email address on file in the provided field**. A temporary password is only received by email if the email entered is associated with the account. The email message also provides instructions to help the student or parent choose a new password.

4. Locate the Naviance generated email in your in-box.
5. Open the email and follow the prompts to reset the password.
