Good morning 8th Grade Orchestra Families!

Northfield Middle School orchestra students have quickly moved onto new skills and pieces since our All-District Orchestra Concert in March. Each group (6th Grade, 7th Grade, 8th Grade and Chamber Orchestra) is working on exciting pieces that are pushing each grade in their individual and group playing. This Orchestra Update will provide you with a few events and assignments that are happening right now in orchestra class.

What have we been working on in class?

All 8th Grade students are working on building skills in <u>Essential Technique for Strings</u>. We recently spent many weeks learning to play in 2nd position. Currently, we are learning to identify written key signatures and intervals, and play in a variety of positions & finger patterns while moving through multiple key signatures. Each instrument needs to shift into many positions on the fingerboard for these scales. Students have handled this challenge well and are playing these new patterns and positions with success! We also continue to work on vibrato - you will see more of this at our concert!

8th Grade Orchestra students are currently working on two orchestral pieces: <u>Hunger Games</u> and <u>Joshua</u>. These pieces are challenging and very different from each other, which allows us to work on a variety of styles. 8th Grade students are also exploring the musical skill of improvisation!

The next NMS Orchestra performance will feature only Middle School Orchestra groups on May 28, 2024 at Northfield MIDDLE SCHOOL. This concert begins at 7:00 pm.

Performance Video 8: Due May 9

In place of a traditional practice calendar, 8th Grade students are assigned specific scales or sections of music to practice and record. I provide EVERY student with specific feedback that can be used to improve playing. Students have an option to revise their playing and turn in a new video - 1 week is provided for this. The current assignment includes measures from <u>Hunger Games</u>.

As the weather turns warm, it can sometimes be challenging to want to practice indoors. Please encourage your student to continue to practice at home - even for a short time. Our upcoming concert pieces are challenging and individual at-home practice is a necessity.
