#### Schedule Change Policy

I understand that I am choosing my classes for the 2020-2021 school year. One or more of my alternate choices will be added to my schedule in the case of a scheduling conflict. I understand that no elective schedule changes will be made after registration. If a scheduling change is necessary for graduation, I will initiate the change on the designated schedule change day the week before school begins. Once the school year begins, students with 6 classes will have until the fifth day of the semester to add a replacement class, and students with 7 classes will have until the midquarter point to drop one class and add a study hall.

#### **Entering Course Requests and Alternates:**

- 1. Log into Skyward using your **STUDENT** username and password; if you use the Skyward App, switch to the full desktop version after logging in. You will not be able to register using a parent's log-in.
- 2. At the left side of the screen, click Schedule.
- 3. On the top right, click Request Courses for 2020-2021 in Northfield High School.
- 4. Click the Request Courses tab at the top.
- 5. Scroll through the list of available courses in the left box and click on a desired course.
- 6. Click the Add Course between the boxes, and the desired course will appear in the right box.
- 7. Continue adding until all desired credit-earning courses appear in the box on the right and your credit total for the year just above the right box is accurate. Remember to add all credit-earning courses—both semester and full year. You will not be able to register for study halls; they will be automatically added in your open hours if you sign up for less than 7 credits.
- 8. If you make a mistake, highlight the course in the right box and click the **Remove Course** tab between the boxes.
- 9. Click the **Request Alternates** tab at the top and follow the same procedure as described above until all alternate courses appear in the box on the right. Alternate courses are identified in the Priority column with numbers.
- 10. When all of your course requests and alternate requests appear in the right box, click the red X at the top right of the box; your requests will be automatically saved.

### Frequently Asked Registration Questions

- How do I register for a study hall?
  - You don't. You only enroll in the credit-earning courses you want to take. Open hours are automatically filled with study halls.
- If I take a study hall, will I still be able to graduate on time?
  - Yes, assuming that you are passing all of your classes each semester. If you
    have failed any courses, talk to your counselor about your situation.
- What if I'm not sure about needing a study hall?
  - Sign up for 7 credits knowing that you have until the midquarter point to drop an
    elective and add a study hall in its place. That gives you almost four weeks to
    experience your schedule without a study hall and determine if you need one.
- What if I change my mind about courses before the end of the school year?
  - o Talk to your counselor.
- How do I make up credits for classes I have failed?
  - o Talk to your counselor.
- How do I register for PSEO classes?
  - You apply and register directly through the individual college. Check page 11 of the Course Registration Guide, and talk to your counselor for more information.
- How do I know if I should take an AP course?
  - Talk to your current teacher in that subject area. Talk to the AP teacher for the course you are considering. Talk to your counselor.
- Where do I learn about any new classes that will be offered at NHS next year?
  - Check the table of contents on pages 1-2 in the Course Registration Guide.
     "(NEW)" appears after every new course, and a complete course description is included on the identified page.
- One of the courses I want to take isn't listed in Skyward when I scroll through the course options. What do I do?
  - Verify on the master course list that the course is actually available to your grade level. If it is, then contact your counselor for help.
- What happens if I don't enter any alternate course choices?
  - If there's a schedule conflict, your counselor will choose a replacement course for you based on what is available.
  - o It is in your best interest to enter alternate course choices.
- What if I sign up for an advanced or honors level course and my current grades drop below the requirements to be in the class?
