

513.2 EARLY ENTRANCE INTO KINDERGARTEN

Children shall be five years of age on or before September 1 of the year in which they start kindergarten and six years of age on or before September 1 of the year in which they start first grade. When a student has successfully completed an accredited kindergarten program, he or she may be placed in first grade, at the parents' request, regardless of age. The Northfield School District will consider early entrance to kindergarten if a child's fifth birthday falls on a date after September 1, and before October 1, provided that the child demonstrates superior levels of intellectual, academic, and social development as specified by the Early Entrance procedures. Such decisions shall be made cautiously due to the possible negative consequences for a student who spends his/her school career as the youngest member in the identity group.

A request must be made in writing directly to the elementary school principal no later than May 1 of the year for which early entrance is requested. Exception to this cutoff can be permitted at the discretion of the Superintendent of Schools.
