The amount of the proposed levy for 2018 is \$19,256,128.89 and represents a 23.62% increase from the prior year. Director of Finance Val Mertesdorf will review the levy and the current year's revised general fund budget. The public is invited to speak following the presentation.

Director of Buildings and Grounds Jim Kulseth will share information about the District's participation in the Xcel Energy Renewable\*Connect program and cost savings as a result of installation of LED lighting at Northfield Middle School.

This action completes the School District's process that began in August with the initial submission of data to the Department of Education, our subsequent review and analysis of the Department's calculation, and the estimate of the School District's property tax base by Rice, Goodhue and Dakota counties. A Truth in Taxation presentation followed by public comment was held as part of the Regular Board Meeting on December 11<sup>th</sup> to provide a final opportunity for community feedback to the proposed levy. This levy, payable in 2018, will be a component of the 2018-19 fiscal budget.

**Superintendent's Recommendation:** Motion to certify to County Auditors the 2017 Payable 2018 Final Certified Levy Limitation and Certification Report in the amount \$19,256,128.89.

2. Fiscal Year 2017-2018 General Fund Budget Revision.  
The Director of Finance Val Mertesdorf is recommending the following revisions to the School Board for the FY 18 general fund budget. The adopted general fund revenue and expenditure budget for FY 18 was \$49,106,038 and \$49,512,860 respectively. The recommended revised budget for FY 18 is revenues of \$50,388,093 and expenditures of

\$51,418,052. The major factors contributing to these changes include increased enrollment and a detailed analysis of the final audited data from FY17.

**Superintendent's Recommendation:** Motion to approve the revised 2017-18 general fund budget of revenues of \$50,388,093 and expenditures of \$51,418,052.

3. Resolution Establishing Combined Polling Places for Multiple Precincts and Designating Hours during which the Polling Places will Remain Open for Voting for School District Elections not Held on the Day of a Statewide Election.

A new election law from the 2017 Legislative Session requires school districts to approve a resolution to combine polling places in the event the school district were to hold a special election. This resolution must be approved by December 31 of each year, whether the school district intends to hold a special election or not. The Board must designate the combined polling places they would use in the future calendar year and notify county auditors by sending them a copy of the resolution. Combined polling places must be a location currently designated for use by a county or municipality.

At the December 4 Board Work Session three options for potential combined polling places were discussed. Administration is recommending Board approval of the combined polling places presented in option two, as listed in the Resolution.

**Superintendent's Recommendation:** Motion to approve the Resolution Establishing Combined Polling Places for Multiple Precincts and Designating Hours during which the Polling Places will Remain Open for Voting for School District Elections not Held on the Day of a Statewide Election.

Shari Bridley received the Education Assistant of the Year award. John Stenz, CEO of FORCE America, received the Friend of Education award for his volunteer work with the annual Business and Technical Trades Career Explorations day.
  - Congratulations to Tom Graupmann for receiving a Distinguished Service Award from the Minnesota State High School League for his work with the League's coaches' education program. Tom received the award on November 25th at US Bank Stadium during the State Football Championship.

  1. TORCH Presentation.  
NHS Assistant Principal Marnie Thompson, who provides support and oversight of the TORCH program, began the presentation by introducing to the School Board the new TORCH team members: Tessa Kiesow, HS TORCH Director, Katie Lovrien, MS TORCH Director, and Teddy Gelderman, TORCH Alumni Services Director. After providing background information, including 13 years of history, each team member provided an update on TORCH programming in their respective areas. An exciting new addition this year is alumni support. Local community college classes are now being offered through a partnership with Riverland. NHS TORCH alumni have an opportunity to earn an AA degree in Northfield.
  2. Summary of Public Hearing regarding the 2017-2018 World's Best Workforce Plan.  
Director of Teaching and Learning Mary Grace Hanson and District Assessment Coordinator Hope Langston summarized the 2017-2018 World's Best Workforce Plan that was presented at a Public Hearing that preceded the Regular School Board meeting and answered Board members' clarifying questions. There are five continuing requirements to the WBWF report that must be submitted to the MN Department of Education each year. (1) All children are ready for school. (2) All third graders can read at grade level. (3) All racial and economic achievement gaps between schools are closed. (4) All students are ready for career and college. (5) All students graduate from high school. The presentation covered the five

areas, the goals from 2016-2017, data that corresponded to the results in each of the areas, the goals for 2017-2018, and action steps to achieve the goals.

## Truth in Taxation | 2017 Pay 2018 Levy Certification | December 11, 2017

The Truth in Taxation presentation is designed to provide an opportunity for the District to share information with the public regarding our levy and budget. The law also allows the public an opportunity to speak.

### Levy Cycle

Each year the county assessors determine each property's estimated market value and assign a class. There are 40 different property classes set by statute in the State of Minnesota. The county auditor calculates the net tax capacity for each taxing jurisdiction. The local tax rate of a jurisdiction is determined by dividing the total certified levy by the net tax capacity to establish rates and then applies those to each property.

The tax capacity for Northfield Public Schools had increased each year. The increase in tax capacity includes increased property values as well as additional taxable parcels.

The levy we set as required by law is a fixed dollar amount. Regardless of whether our tax capacity is growing, we are still collecting that dollar amount. A decrease in our tax capacity does not necessarily indicate a decrease in the amount of taxes collected.

There are several factors that affect your property tax amount. The most significant being our voter approved referendum as well as our increased enrollment. More than 60% of our levy is enrollment based formulas. Other factors include legislative changes, levy adjustments from prior years, changes in market values, class rates and levies by other taxing jurisdictions.

### Legislative Impacts

The Long Term Facilities Maintenance Revenue program is entering its third year. The program provides districts with needed funding to maintain facilities. The Pay 17 levy had \$292/pupil unit and the Pay 18 levy has \$380/pupil unit. These funds are used to maintain or replace existing infrastructure. Northfield has seen an increase in enrollment, which further increases the amount we can levy for. The same holds true if our enrollment were to decline, this levy would also decrease.

### 2017 Pay 2018 Property Tax Levy Summary

Our certified levy authority is up \$3,679,064.29 or 23.62% compared to one year ago. Our proposed Pay 2018 levy is a total of \$19,256,128.89.

This is due to a few factors, including:

1. Voter approved operating referendum increase of \$470.15 per pupil.
2. Phased in Long Term Facilities Maintenance (LTFM) revenue.
3. Increase in enrollment

### **Levy Authority vs. Certification**

Our Pay 2018 property tax levy seeks to use the maximum authority provided by the Minnesota Department of Education. By seeking maximum authority, the District will levy \$3,679,064.29 more than it did last year. These funds will be used judiciously to maintain our programming for as long as possible.

### **2017 Property Tax Levy Breakdown**

The District's property tax levy of \$19,256,128.89 supports the following:

- Debt Service 28%
- General Fund: Referendum 52%
- General Fund: Other 14%
  - Includes Location Equity Revenue, Operating Capital, LTFM, Building Lease, and OPEB
- Capital Levy: 4%
- Community Services: 2%

### **Subtotal Comparisons**

The District's Pay 2018 levy includes a 7.56% increase in debt service, a 32.25% increase in general fund dollars and a 2.53% increase in community services. The District's Pay 2018 levy includes a 27.0% increase in the amount authorized by the voters and a 16.84% increase in the 'other' portion of the levy.

The general fund increase is a direct result of the increased operating referendum, increased enrollment and phased increase of the long term facilities maintenance revenue. The increase in our community services fund is primarily due to our early childhood family education revenue, which the legislature has tied to increases in the basic formula. Our debt service increased slightly based on the payment structure of our bonds and a reduction in our debt excess adjustment.

As a testament to this community's generous support of education you can see that 69% of our total levy is voter approved.

### **Levy History**

I think it is important to note that over the last six years our average increase has been 3.5%. Three out of six years we decreased our levy. We are incredibly fortunate to live in a community that supports education wholeheartedly. The burden on taxpayers is significant and unfortunately is not equitable across the state due to many legislative rules. We will continue to be responsible stewards and ensure the funds are well spent.

## 2017-18 General Fund Budget Amendment | December 11, 2017

Each year the District revises the General Fund Budget after the year has started and we have more accurate information. As a requirement of the Truth in Taxation process we must discuss the budget and we take the opportunity to revise it at this time.

We now have our audited financials from the prior fiscal year, our October 1 enrollment is no longer a projection, we have settled our employment agreements, hired staff, and we have our allocations for federal funding from MDE. We take all this information and compare it to the adopted budget presented in June and see which areas of the budget need to be adjusted. We input the October 1<sup>st</sup> enrollment and the final 16-17 enrollment into our projection model and use historical averages and the cohort survival method to predict future enrollment. In June, we projected that we would have roughly 4,424 weighted pupil units, which is typically a conservative estimate. With our updated Oct 1<sup>st</sup> enrollment, we are now showing 4,435 weighted pupil units, a slight increase.

The General Fund Budget Amendment will include increasing revenues by \$1,282,055, which is due to the increased enrollment, a stronger special education estimate and an increase in both federal and local sources. In June, we had a conservative amount budgeted for special education revenue with the uncertainty surrounding the first year impact of CVSEC.

The General Fund Budget Amendment will include increasing expenditures by \$1,905,192. There are several factors creating this increase. The adopted budget is typically forecasted from the current fiscal year budget. Once the audit is complete, we do a budget to actual analysis to make sure we are on track or make corrections if needed.

- Salaries – Increase approximately \$245,000
  - Primarily due to increase in special education students – 12% increase in educational assistants from 15-16 to 16-17.
- Benefits – Increase approximately \$273,000
  - Retiree payments – We have seen a significant number of retirees over the past few years and some of our contracts provide health insurance after retirement. We've seen about a 20% increase. We do get some additional funding through the OPEB levy to help offset part of this cost.
  - 403(b) match participation increase.
- Purchased Services – Increase approximately \$540,000
  - Transportation – We planned for an increase when we joined the Big 9 conference, but it was an estimate since we were unsure of the actual additional cost. The past two years has been roughly \$50,000 more. We also have a new contract with Benjamin Bus.
  - Electricity – We have seen a 20+% increase the last two years. This accounts for about \$300,000.
- Supplies/Other – Increase \$206,000
  - This is a one-time increase to purchase a standardized reading curriculum for all the elementary schools.
- Capital/Equipment – Increase \$379,000
  - There were additional LTFM projects that were prioritized for this year.

The 2017-18 adopted budget is based on several estimates and the unassigned fund balance is one of them. We ended FY17 better than expected. We are still projecting to spend down the unassigned fund balance and the fund balance in total. We are currently projected to end FY2017-18 with 22.6% unassigned fund balance as a percentage of our total general fund expenditures.

The District continues to strive to be good stewards of the dollars entrusted to us by the taxpayers. The District has demonstrated this by using the fund balance to pay for the security upgrades instead of borrowing funds, refunding debt so the taxpayers don't endure as much of a burden, and increasing the unassigned fund balance consistently over the last several years even in years of limited revenue increases. The District's goal is to provide a high quality educational experience for all of our learners.



## TRUTH IN TAXATION 2017 Pay 2018 Levy Certification

12/11/2017

### Levy Cycle

1. Assessors determine a property's estimated market value and assign a property class to each parcel.
2. The County Auditor calculates the net tax capacity for each parcel in the county, as well as the total net tax capacity for each taxing jurisdiction.
  - a) A property's net tax capacity is determined by multiplying the property's market value by the relevant class rate.
    - i. Class rates are set by statute, vary by property type, and are uniform statewide.
3. The local tax rate of a taxing jurisdiction is determined by dividing the jurisdiction's total levy by the jurisdiction's taxable net tax capacity.
  - a) Each jurisdiction sets its own levy and follows specific limits set by state law.

## Levy Cycle

4. The County Auditor divides the final levy by the District's net tax capacity (or referendum market value) to establish rates.
5. The County Auditor applies those rates to each parcel and prepares the final statements for mailing.
6. Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) sets the maximum levy limit for each school district, based on current legislation and formulas.
7. The School Board adopts a proposed levy in September, holds a public meeting, then finalizes the levy amount in December.

## Property Tax Changes

Many factors may cause the individual property tax statement to increase or decrease from year to year:

- Voter approved referendums
- Changes in enrollment
- Levy adjustments to prior years
- Legislative changes
- Changes in market values
- Changes in class rates/history
- Levies by other taxing jurisdictions

## Legislative Impacts

- Phased increase of Long Term Facilities Maintenance Revenue for FY18
  - Based on Commissioner's School Facilities Working Group recommendations (\$193/pu – FY17 | \$292/pu – FY18 | \$380/pu – FY19)
  - Reduces disparities in opportunities to fund costs of facilities maintenance projects
  - A 10-year, board approved plan is required to receive revenue
  - Replaces the health & safety and deferred maintenance revenue programs









# MS Energy Consumption History




# MS Current Electric Consumption as compared to dates in FY17

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING COMBINED POLLING PLACES  
FOR MULTIPLE PRECINCTS AND  
DESIGNATING HOURS DURING WHICH THE POLLING  
PLACES WILL REMAIN OPEN FOR VOTING  
FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTIONS NOT HELD  
ON THE DAY OF A STATEWIDE ELECTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Independent School District No.659, State of Minnesota, as follows:

1. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.11, the precincts and polling places for school district elections are those precincts or parts of precincts located within the boundaries of the school district which have been established by the cities or towns located in whole or in part within the school district. The board hereby confirms those precincts and polling places so established by those municipalities.

2. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.11, the board may establish a combined polling place for several precincts for school district elections not held on the day of a statewide election. Each combined polling place must be a polling place that has been designated by a county or municipality. The notice must be a nonforwardable notice mailed at least twenty-five (25) days before the date of the first election to which it will apply. A notice that is returned as undeliverable must be forwarded immediately to the appropriate county auditor, who shall change the registrant's status to "challenged" in the statewide registration system.

(If a combined polling place is changed, the change must be adopted at least ninety (90) days prior to the first election where it will be used unless that polling place has become unavailable for use.)
