SUBJECT: Proposal to Conduct Scientific, Random-Sample Survey and Related Consultation

## Summary of Need

The Northfield Public Schools desires to collect and analyze qualitative and quantitative perceptions of the District in general, and more specifically feedback about an unsuccessful capital project referendum in 2017 to determine feasibility of a 2018 capital project referendum.

## Proposed Services

Springsted Incorporated will plan, design, administer, summarize and interpret a scientific, random-sample survey to measure constituent perceptions about the District. The parameters of the survey will be 400 random-sample phone interviews of registered voters, controlled for key demography, and a 35 item questionnaire, producing an error of measurement of approximately $+/-4.84 \%$. Up to two of the questions may be open-ended probes. Interviews will be conducted in English and Spanish. Data analyses will be with use of VAN and expanded Crosstabs.

Deliverables on the survey project include a Workbook of detailed data, PowerPoint summary of key findings, and a Workbook of open-ended responses (if open-ended questions are used in questionnaire). All summaries will be provided to the District in PDF format for duplication by the District as needed.

## Delivery of Services

The delivery of services will be coordinated by Don Lifto with support from Kelly Smith and other professional staff at Springsted as needed depending on the expertise and resources required by the District. Most survey projects take 8 - 10 weeks to complete depending on the turnaround time during development of the questionnaire. Delivery of the Workbook of open-ended responses generally takes $5-10$ business days longer than production of the Workbook detail and PowerPoint.

## *Project Cost

The professional fee for consultation services provided to the District shall be $\$ 22,810$. This fee is inclusive of professional time for two meetings in Northfield to work on questionnaire development and to review and present results of the survey with administrative staff and/or the Board of Education. Additional trips to the District, if requested, will be billed at an hourly rate of $\$ 260$. An initial billing of $40 \%$ of the fee will be processed when data is ordered and the project commences. A second billing for the balance will be processed when all data is collected and final reports are provided to the District
*Springsted provides its financial advisory clients with discounts on scientific, random-sample surveys. If Springsted is selected as the District's municipal advisor or Northfield commits to using Springsted as its advisor on its next bond sale before final billing on the project, the professional fee for the survey will be reduced by $\$ 3,400$. In the event Northfield accesses the discount, the hourly charge for meetings more than two will be waived.

## Other Services

Springsted provides an array of referendum support services. Additional services, if requested by the District, will be provided on a quotation and approval basis under the terms of this agreement. The district has expressed interest in the following services: Post-Election Analysis at $\$ 2,700$; Voter File \& Target Structure at $\$ 750$.
