

Need Care Before or After School? Join Kid Ventures!

What: Kid Ventures is the district’s school-age care program that operates through Community Education. Kid Ventures runs before and after school at each of the three elementary schools for children in grades K-5.

When: Kid Ventures opens at 6:30 AM and runs until the start of the school day and again after school, from dismissal until 6:00 PM. Kid Ventures also operates on most school release days and in the summer (Children must have completed kindergarten to attend the summer session).

Mission: Kid Ventures mission is to foster a fun atmosphere where children are encouraged to explore new interests and develop new friendships. Throughout the program, children will participate in a variety of hands-on activities that build social, emotional, physical, and academic development.

Schedule Options: Families must sign up for a consistent schedule with a minimum of two days per week. This means that children must be registered at least two mornings per week and/or two afternoons per week.

Registration: Registration for the 2024-2025 school year will open in mid April. All registration should be completed online at:
