Your child may be eligible for additional educational services through Title 1, and/or the Federal McKinney-Vento Act. Eligibility can be determined by completing this questionnaire. The purpose of this information is to ensure the rights of your children and youth under the McKinney-Vento Act.

- In a shelter (family shelter, domestic violence, youth or temporary housing)
- In a motel, hotel, or weekly ratehousing
- Doubled up with friends or relatives because you lost your housing, or you cannot find or afford housing

- On the street
- Temporary or emergency foster care
- With friends or relatives because you are an unaccompanied youth (youth not in the physical custody of parent or guardian)

Your eligible children have the right to:

- Enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
- Enroll in school and attend classes while the school gathers needed documents.
- Enroll in the local school; or continue attending their school of origin (the school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled), if that is your preference and is feasible.
- Receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if you request this.
- Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to your children’s needs.
- Receive free school breakfast and lunch.
