Many of the questions and comments defy a logical answer or response.

Our students and staff shouldn't have to be thinking about this.

Schools are safe places statistically. The news, however, isn't able to paint them that way these days, so our students and staff don't get to think of them that way either. Something simply needs to change, and while our leaders and government officials sort out what those changes entail, we are left to consider our role: what can we do to maximize school safety?

So we lock doors, we *talk* to students, we *listen* for concerning information, we *reach out* to students, we *create* support networks, we *respond* to information we receive, and we *show*, on a daily basis, that we care about the students here. No one knows the exact formula that will prevent this type of school violence, but at NHS we will be unrelenting in our efforts to find the right mix, so our students and staff can be focused solely on learning each and every day they are here.

Thank you for your continued partnership in the education and safety of our students.
