Required Training Schedule

CPR Training:

This is a mandatory training for all PCAs and for Special Education teachers in Early Childhood and Low Incidence programs or those that work with medically fragile students.

I will be offering two sessions of CPR training on Tuesday, August 25, which is the week before pre-school workshops. You need to attend only one session. If you want a certification card, the cost is \$5.00.

Bloodborne Pathogens:

This is mandatory annual training for all PCAs, Special Education teachers in Early Childhood and Low Incidence programs or those that work with medically fragile students, nurses, custodians, coaches and industrial arts instructors. Please refer to the “Mandated Annual Training” letter from Elizabeth Bade and Jim Kulseth.

Educational Assistant (EA) – Personal Care Assistant (PCA) Training:

This training is mandatory for NEW PCAs who work in Special Education. If you are new or you were hired last year, but never trained, this training IS FOR YOU.

Training includes body mechanics, transfers, assistance with walking (gait), and the use of a mechanical lift. (Hoyer Lift).
