-Two K12 Education Conference Committees-

- 1. Teacher Licensure
- 2. Eduation Funding and Policy.
- -Targets for Conference Committees should be set by the end of the week
- -Education spending is likely to be between \$500-\$550 Million, optimistic it will will include 2/2 % on the formula.(\$371 million)
- -Tax Committee includes:
- -Equalization Bill and Ag2 School Bond tax credit

ESSA Update:

- -MN on track to submit the state's plan in September.
- -Guest speakers from both Senator Franken and Representative Emmer's office
- -Both legislators supportive of the bill because of the increased local control it provides to districts
- -Senator Franken has introduced legislation to address teacher shortage in rural America as well as a bill to provide resources to grow business and K12 education partnerships to better prepare students and to address the nation's

skills gap.

-Both expressed concern around the President's proposed education budget which represents a \$9.0 billion or 13.5% reduction including the elimination of Americorp, 21st Century Learning grant, flat funding for special education. The president's budget does include \$1.4 billion for school choice including charter and private school youchers.
