COMMON CONCERNS IN SCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN

Disease: Strep Throat, Scarlet Fever, Scarlatina

Symptoms: Fever, sore throat, headache, nausea, vomiting. (If associated with rash it is called Scarlet Fever/Scarlatina)

Incubation Period: 1-3 days

Usual School Action and Comments on Communicability:

- 1. If positive for strep, exclude from school until 24 hours after antibiotic treatment is started and until clinically well.
- 2. Communicable until 24 hours after treatment is started
- 3. Exclude until fever is less than 100 degrees for 24 hours.

Source of Infection and Mode of Transmission: Bacteria spread directly from nose or throat discharges of infected persons.

Note: Children and adolescents should not be given aspirin containing medications unless specifically prescribed by physician. Good hand washing is the best prevention of disease
